STABLING

Saturday Stall Only - Rivendell Stables Dressage Show I - \$40 (Haul-in 7am Sat/Haul-out 1.5 hours after last Sat class)

Sunday Stall Only - Rivendell Stables Dressage Show II - \$40 (Haul-in 7am Sun/Haul-out 1.5 hours after last Sun class)

Weekend - Rivendell Stables Dressage Show I and Show II - \$65 (Haul-in after 12pm Friday /Haul-out 1.5 hours after last Sun class)

- Stalls will be bedded. Additional shavings can be purchased from the on-site show office
- Additional \$25 per stall cleaning fee applied for all unpicked stall.
- All stalls are inspected prior to and after the show. Damage to any wood stall will be fined \$50

HAUL-IN

A \$35 per horse fee to be charged if stall is not reserved

AWARDS

Each division will be pinned separately. Ribbons for 1st-6th place

Championships awarded for High Percentage and Reserve High Percentage for each Level/Division

All "Test of Choice" classes are to be scored together if smaller than 6 riders

RULES/REGULATIONS: Each participant is responsible for knowing the USDF/EF Rules /Regulations on tack, bits, tests and other show related topics. Please visit usdf.org or usef.org with questions or come directly to the show office for all inquiries.

Rivendell Stables Show I and Show II **COVID PROTOCOL:** follow current USEF/USDF Guidelines

DOGS: Well behaved dogs welcome. Please clean up after your dog. ALL dogs must be leashed, with current ID and vaccination tags. A \$25 fee will be issued for ANY dogs not on leash.

SCHOOLING: A \$35 per day fee will be assessed for non-competing horses. Schooling in competing arena will be allowed from 3pm Friday until 45 minutes before commencement on the day of the show.

LUNGING: Lunging is only permitted in designated areas; prohibited on grass and in show arenas.

STALLIONS: All stallions must be handled by an adult over the age of 18. On site stallions are the responsibility of the owner/handler/trainer.

FOOTING: One outdoor sand arena and compaction sand indoor warm-up arena.

HELMETS: Required to be on and buckled at all times while mounted according to USEF.

REFUNDS: Full refund up to Closing Date other than Office Fee(s). NO refunds after Closing Date.

RIDE TIMES: Ride times will be posted on ADA website, Rivendell Stables Facebook and Rivendellstable.com.

FOOD and FACILITIES: On site food and beverage will be available for purchase. Restroom available on site.
