



## **CANTER Perpetual Achievement Award**

The ***CANTER Perpetual Achievement Award*** was established and is sponsored by the Communication Alliance to Network Thoroughbred Ex-Racehorses in order to acknowledge the success of Thoroughbreds, and especially retiring/non-competitive racehorses, in the sport of dressage; thereby encouraging more people to consider this remarkably versatile and athletic breed as their preferred mount.

### **Requirements for eligibility:**

1. The horse must be of the Thoroughbred breed and be registered with The Jockey Club Registry.
2. Riders must include their Thoroughbred's name, microchip, lip or digital tattoo/registry number as registered with The Jockey Club on the entry form in order for the horse's eligibility to be verified.
3. The award is open to Thoroughbreds of all levels or a combination of levels.
4. The award will be given annually to the Thoroughbred with the highest percentage at the end of the season competing in ADA Sanctioned Schooling Shows.
5. Horse & Rider must meet ADA High Percentage Awards' general requirements as listed in the ADA Omnibus.
6. Recipients of this trophy will be ineligible for nomination for the year immediately following their award but may be re-nominated thereafter.
7. Rider must submit a completed nomination form no later than September 15, 2024, for their registration with the Jockey Club Registry to be verified.
