ENTRIES:

- All classes are \$30 each
- Office fees are \$30 per entry, per show. If showing both days, an office fee must be added for each day.
- All levels include divisions as follows: Junior, Adult Amateur, Open
- Please use the CAEC entry form (electronic or paper) available on our website at www.caecdressage.com when entering
- Online entries due June 14, 2024. Paper entries must be postmarked by June 14, 2024 and mailed to Jen Meyering 2886 Sunrise Avenue Holland, MI 49424
- Make checks payable to *Centennial Acres Equestrian Center*
- Rides are filled as entries are received.
- No entries will be accepted without:
 - Accurate, full payment
 - Proper signatures on both ADA & CAEC release forms
 - Negative, current Coggins test
 - Flu/Rhino vaccine record
- Entries that are accurate, complete and include full, correct payment will be entered into a raffle. The winner will be randomly selected to win a \$50 Visa gift card!

POST ENTRIES: At discretion of show management with 50% additional entry fee.

REFUNDS: Full refund up to closing date, less office fees. No refunds after the closing date.

TIMES: Ride times will be posted on ADA website, Centennial Acres Dressage Facebook page and caecdressage.com. These will be posted as soon as they are available.

ARENAS & FOOTING: Intro and Training Level tests will be ridden in a small arena (20m x 40m). First Level, Second Level, TOC & Freestyles will be ridden in a large arena (20m x 60m). Leadline and Equitation class arena size is TBD. Premium sand warm up and show

arenas. Warm up takes place in a full sized indoor arena. Lunging is only permitted in the small arena on the east side of small barn.

STABLING: Permanent 12x12 stalls. Stabling is limited and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. \$80 flat rate. Shavings may be purchased for \$9 per bag. Initial bedding is *not* provided. On site night check/early morning feed service available for hire; inquire at the show office upon arrival.

HAUL-IN: A haul-in fee of \$30 per horse, per day, is required for non-stabled guest competition horses.

TEST OF CHOICE (TOC): Test of Choice classes are to be scored together. Divisions are pinned separately.

FREESTYLES: Please specify which test will be ridden on entry form. Music must be submitted to the show office one day prior for sound check. Premium sound system on site.

LEADLINE: For ages 8 and under; walk only. Handlers must have appropriate footwear. Awards for all participants.

AWARDS: Each division will be pinned separately. Ribbons are awarded for first through sixth place. Prizes are awarded for first place. *Best Turned Out Horse and Rider* awards will be given to one Junior and one Adult Amateur rider with the best turnout (each show day), as voted by the judge. Winners will receive \$50 gift cards to Sporthorse Saddlery.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: High Percentage and Reserve High Percentage ribbons for each level/division, including freestyles. Prizes are awarded for High Percentage Champions.

SCHOOLING: Schooling will be available in the show arena on Thursday June 27 from 1pm-7pm, and Friday June 28 for 90 minutes after the last ride of the day. Schooling is available in the indoor and small outdoor arenas when the show arena is closed. Barn closes at 9pm.

RULES/REGULATIONS: Each participant is responsible for knowing the USDF/USEF Rules & Regulations on tack, bits, tests, and other show related topics. Please visit usdf.org or usef.org with questions or come directly to the show office.

RELEASE FORMS: CAEC release forms must be signed by all riders. No one may ride on property without having signed a form, including trainers on client horses. Release form is available at www.caecdressage.com and will be available in the show office.

HELMETS: Helmets are required to be on and buckled at all times while mounted according to USEF.

STALLIONS: Please notify the office ahead of time if you will be bringing a stallion. All stallions must be handled by an adult over the age of 18. On site stallions are the responsibility of the owner/handler/rider.
